PPB was originally founded in 1978 as Proctor Paper and Board by John Proctor in Leeds as a paper and board stockist merchant. Today, PPB remains a family business and has since invested heavily to provide a wide range of plastic, paper, board, and ACM display materials and finishing services for the screen print, large format litho print, and the digital display markets as well as supplying sign makers and fabricators.

PPB now have two centres of operation, in Leeds and Dartford, and stock held in over 85,000 square feet of modern high bay warehousing. 95% of deliveries are made by their own lorry fleet throughout the U.K. On an average day the fleet will handle around 100 tonnes of material, and the staff pick and convert over 4500 order lines every month.

OUR CHALLENGE

PPB faced the challenge of using Citrix and NetScaler which was starting to present several challenges, particularly concerning security and cost. Despite security and vulnerabilities, and constant patches, the support of Citrix and Netscaler was a big concern for us. Additionally, the expense of deploying and maintaining Citrix and NetScaler solutions was substantial. Not only this we were also rolling out a new ERP solution and needed a solution other than a standard VPN for our Remote Users.

PPB approached their IT partner, Kuiper Technology, and on their recommendation, decided to run tests using iQuila.
